UNIFORM INFRACTIONS/PROPER GROOMING

As outlined in the General Rules for All Catholic Primary Schools and by extension Xavier's Lower School:

"Uniforms symbolize oneness, pride, unity and [most importantly] discipline. Scholars are expected to wear their **complete** uniform daily with pride. Scholars **will not** be permitted to attend class if they are improperly attired.

- Boys' haircut should be low and well groomed at all times.
- Girls are NOT permitted to wear weaves, hair extensions or hoop earrings."

Effective **Wednesday**, **March 19**, **2025** any student in violation of these rules will be sent home.
