

School Fee Payment Options

There are now only 2 school fee payment options available:

Term 2 fees past due: December 1, 2025 (Grade 6 students *ONLY* an additional **\$180** will automatically be added to the school fee payment) **-This is separate from the Activity Fee**

Term 3 Fees are due: March 1, 2026

For those parents on the payment plan, please be sure to contact Mrs. K. Hall khall@cec.edu.bs to ensure your monthly payments are current to avoid any interruptions in your child's learning.

Please note, if Term 2 fee payments are not current, students will not be allowed in classes as of **Friday, January 16, 2026.**

Please note that school is dismissed at **3:00 p.m.**

The school's office closes promptly at 4:00 p.m.

You are encouraged to collect your child ON TIME.

Effective immediately, any student remaining **after 3:15 p.m.** (*who is NOT a part of an after school club/class/program*) will **automatically** be sent to aftercare to ensure proper supervision and safety.

The fee for aftercare is **\$5.00**. *Parents will be expected to pay this fee for students remaining after 3:30 p.m.*
